ABOUT US

Dogwood Transitional Care Unit (TCU) is a short-stay transitional care unit for patients waiting to move into long-term care or waiting for community services to be secured.

Referrals and eligibility

When a patient in acute care no longer needs hospital-level care, the care team will determine if the patient's care needs can be temporarily met at Dogwood Transitional Care Unit.

Once Dogwood TCU is determined to be the most appropriate care location, the health-care team will complete the referral. The healthcare team will approach the patient or their family to obtain consent prior to finalizing the transfer.


